



**Statement regarding California Proposition 65 and products manufactured by
MAGNETICS, a Division of Spang & Company.**

California Proposition 65, known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, intends to protect California citizens from substances determined to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. Under the administration of the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), there are now over 950 chemicals listed under Proposition 65. California Proposition 65 obligates businesses operating in California to provide clear and reasonable warnings before knowingly and intentionally exposing Californians to chemicals that are included in the Proposition 65 List. Magnetics has issued no such warnings.

Actual exposure is a function of how the product is used, misused, or disposed. Although it is possible that some of our products may contain Proposition 65 listed substances, in their normal use as electronic or electrical system components there is no direct exposure such as contact with skin, ingestion, or inhalation. Therefore, a warning label is not required stating that our products contain chemicals that may cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm.
